Discussion Topics:

- Hybrid Worship Services: Judy requested help with technology from Rev Webster Gibson, Committee on Congregational Missions (CCM) Chair. Phil from Christ Church in Winchester has been assisting Good Shepherd with technology.
- Our Place in the Diocese:
 - Good Shepherd is a mission church. 50 missions out of 180 congregations. Size is not always a factor (example: St. Gabriel’s in Leesburg is a mission church with hundreds of parishioners)
